Barkston and Syston Parish Council

A Meeting of the Parish Council was held in the Village Hall on Monday 18th July. All members of the Parish Council were present, together with County Councillor Ray Wootten. Two members of the public attended. Apologies were received from District Councillor Trevor Scott.

The meeting commenced with the public forum, and a member of the public asked the Council to note that a planning application had been submitted for two 130 foot high wind turbines which, while not within Barkston, would certainly be visible from many points within the village. Another member of the public asked about the pedestrian crossing, and was advised that this was not on the list at the moment owing to financial restraints.

As usual, many highways matters were discussed. Councillor Wootten advised that the school safety zone would not now be implemented, and the County Council were instead looking at some form of restriction involving yellow lines. After a long discussion it was agreed to support a scheme involving no parking at any time on both sides of the road from the end of the existing restriction outside the school, and a point opposite, around the corner to the end of the Churchyard. The Area Surveyor had given details of action proposed to remedy the various deficiencies identified in the recent "walkabout" although many of these would not be done immediately.

A request had been made via Councillor Wootten for reactive speed signs, and he advised that there was no finance available in the current financial year. The signs were available to buy at £6,500 each. It was agreed to note this for the budget meeting in November.

The website continued to be quite well used. Should anyone have anything to publicise, of a local nature, please contact the Clerk.

The sites consultation was nearing a conclusion, and a meeting had been held at The Guildhall last week so that SKDC could receive comments from Parishes on the recommendations which they were making to the Cabinet. It was noted that no sites were proposed for development in Barkston.

The scheme of re-planting for the frontage of the Burial Ground was discussed, and it was agreed that 5 trees each side of the gate would be adequate. The Council agreed to purchase appropriate materials to replace the damaged guttering on the Bier Shelter. A quotation for cutting the hedges was considered and agreed.

The next meeting is on MONDAY 12th SEPTEMBER 2011 at 7.45 pm at the VILLAGE HALL.
