## **1. MINUTES**

A resident raised concerns over the regular flooding on Hough Road which was resulting vehicles damaging the Verge.

Another resident asked about the Parish councils' role in the community and how they can engage with the community more. Such as re instating the village magazine and communicating via social media. The chair advised that unfortunately no one had come forward to continue the village newsletter when the previous editor gave notice.

Concerns were raised over the condition of the road/path in front of the arms houses and it was confirmed that the concerns for the safety of the residents has been raised with Highways and is an ongoing issue.
